## “Reflections”

Thomas Leroy Campbell departed this life for a more peaceful one on Saturday, November 1, 1986 at the District of Columbia General Hospital.

Leroy was the son of Thomas and Bertha Campbell. He attended St. Ann's Academy. He was employed for thirty-six years as a Special Delivery Carrier at the City Post Office.

Leroy has been a member of St. Cyprian Church since the early twenties. He made his marriage vows with Flossie Plater at St. Cyprian's Church. Their loving union produced four children: Plater T., Alvado F., Phyllis Campbell Toliver and the late Burdette J. Campbell.

Leroy, though attentive to his family, found time to be very active in Parish activities. He was devoted to the church which led him to work with senior citizens. He never knew how to say no. A few of his activities were: President of the Holy Name Society, worked with the St. Vincent De Paul Society for thirty years, taking the handicapped and senior citizens to church, clinic, bank and the store. He helped to open the first St. Vincent De Paul store, worked with the Credit Union, was Chairman of the original Bingo program, worked with the Urban League, was a member of the Knights of St. John, remained active ten years after being incapacitated. He had a deep devotion to the Blessed Mother and the Rosary.

Leroy leaves to cherish his memory a devoted wife and mother, Flossie; his sons, Plater Thomas and Alvado Francis; his daughter, Phyllis; a brother, Herman; three sisters, Marie Brown, Cecilia Massey and Louise Ferbee. He was blessed to see his children's children, fourteen in number: Ronald, Perea, Stephanie, Steven, Gregory, Celeste, Maureen, Christine, Patrick, Donna, Mark, Dwayne, Victoria and Sidney.

Leroy joined his parents, Thomas and Bertha, on the Solemnity of All Saints, 1986. His love will be with us as long as we live.
